Applicant's vehicle used on the road test must meet all of these DPS requirements:

- Proof of current liability insurance (in paper format only proof via smart phone will not be accepted) for the vehicle to be used for the road test.
- Current registration sticker.
- Current inspection sticker (not required if you are borrowing the vehicle and it is properly registered in a state that does not require a sticker).
- Two license plates with the front plate attached to the bumper. It's not required if
 you are borrowing the vehicle and it is properly registered in a state that does not
 require two plates.
- ALL brake lights must work.
- No unusual mechanical issues (such as having doors that do not open from inside or outside the vehicle - this will result in failure of the vehicle inspection)
- If your vehicle does not meet the DPS's requirements, provide a vehicle that does

Note:

- If you use a rental vehicle for the test, the person taking the driving test must be listed on the rental agreement as an authorized driver.
- You must show proof that the rental vehicle is covered by liability insurance either by accepting the liability damage waiver when you rent the vehicle or by showing proof that your personal auto liability insurance covers rental vehicles.
- **NO** additional passengers (this includes infants, children, family members and / or friends) will be allowed in the vehicle during the driving test.
